## **MoDOT to close Broadway ramp at night, starting March 14** *Right lane of two-lane ramp closed around the clock for month*

ST. LOUIS – The Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT), and its contractor, Millstone Bangert, have closed the right lane of the two-lane ramp from eastbound Interstate 70 to Broadway for preparatory work for the new Cass Bridge. That lane will remain closed for more than a month to allow crews to complete that work.

In addition, starting Monday, March 14, crews will close the Broadway ramp from eastbound I-70 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. daily to complete preparations to construct the Cass Bridge. Drivers can use the 10<sup>th</sup> Street ramp and take Howard to North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Broadway or access Broadway from the express lanes to detour around the closure. Crews should be finished with the nightly work by Saturday, March 19.

The \$3.95 million reconstruction project is part of the New Mississippi River Bridge corridor and will tie into the new Missouri Interstate 70 interchange.
