MoDOT awards final Missouri project on Mississippi River Bridge corridor

Interchange work in St. Louis City to take about two years

ST. LOUIS – The Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) has the final pieces of the new Mississippi River Bridge project set for construction after the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission awarded the Missouri I-70 interchange to Millstone Bangert, Inc., for \$21.8 million on May 4.

The interchange project will construct the roadway, ramps and bridges needed to connect the new Mississippi River Bridge into I-70 and Cass Avenue in St. Louis City.

Work on the Missouri interchange will start within the next month. Work will continue for about two years.
