



## PROJECT VISITOR CHECKLIST

1. All visitors to the Site must report to and sign in and out at the main office area before entering and exiting the Site. All visitors must be accompanied by an MTA Sponsor and obtain the approval of the Site Superintendent before entering the Site.
2. All visitors are required to sign the Project Visitor Release form before entering the Site.
3. All visitors are prohibited from taking photographs, publishing or advertising any information, etc. that is obtained as a result of gaining access to the project Site without the expressed written consent of Massman, Traylor, Alberici, A Joint Venture (MTA).
4. The following conditions must be observed during a Site visit:
  - No alcohol, controlled substances, weapons, contraband or hazardous substance of any kind whatsoever shall be permitted on the Site.
  - Appropriate clothing for a Site visit includes sturdy work boots (above the ankle), long pants and shirt with sleeves.
  - Personal protective equipment will be furnished by MTA and is required to be worn at all times while on the Site. This will include hard hats, safety glasses, Type III or Type V flotation devices, and any other safety equipment required by MTA.
  - All posted job rules shall apply to visitors as well as employees.
  - All warning signs and barricades must be obeyed.
  - Do not walk or stand near unprotected edges of barges.
  - Do not stray from the approved pass for access and egress.
  - Do not enter areas with inadequate lighting.
  - Smoking is prohibited except in designated areas.
  - Do not touch or walk on welding leads, wires, piping, ductwork, conduit or other construction materials of any kind.
  - Do not lean on or reach beyond any handrails or barricades.
  - Be aware that walking surfaces will be uneven or have other impediments not present in a finished product and that extreme care should be taken with each step.
  - In the event of an emergency evacuation, report to the employee parking area on the Missouri shore north of the MTA dock and await further instructions.
  - Report any hazards to an MTA representative.
