MoDOT to close reversible lanes next week
(Department plans to close reversible lanes for two months)

ST. LOUIS – The Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) and its contractor Fred Weber, Inc., will close the Interstate 70 reversible lanes February 17 for two months as part of constructing the Madison Street bridge over the interstate.

Closing the reversible lanes will help crews construct the middle support structures needed for the bridge.

The work is being done in conjunction with constructing the new Mississippi River Bridge to relocate I-70 across the Mississippi River.

After the lanes reopen in late April, they will remain open until about mid-June before MoDOT crews need to close them for another six weeks to construct the St. Louis Avenue bridge.
